

PRESIDENT: OK, go ahead.

SENATOR DE CAMP: He is asking, I wasn't here for the debate yesterday, he is asking to move it back to put on an amendment to....

PRESIDENT: His motion now is only to reconsider. That is all that we have before us.

SENATOR DE CAMP: OK.

PRESIDENT: He may propose something else, but the only thing before the body now is to reconsider the action on LB779. If you are in favor of the reconsideration of the action on 779 vote aye, if not vote no. Question is shall the action on 779 yesterday on Final Reading be reconsidered. That motion takes 25 votes. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I ask for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner asking for a roll call vote and a record vote. Clerk will clear the board.

CLERK: Took roll call vote. 21 ayes, 17 nays and 11 not voting. (vote appears on page 1069-1070 of the Legislative Journal).

PRESIDENT: Motion to reconsider fails. Do we have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Yes. Attorney Generals opinion to Senator Fowler will appear in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: Read Fellman motion regarding 877.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, I have two motions and I don't know which one you have first.

CLERK: I would assume that you would want the computerized motion first.

SENATOR FELLMAN: OK. I move that this be returned for the amendment. I...the amendment....do you want me to go into the amendment?

PRESIDENT: You had better.

SENATOR FELLMAN: This amendment, members of the legislature calls for the addition to the state income tax return of a provision that is not on the federal tax return, allowing a person to check a blank and have a dollar deducted to the political parties. This is now done on the Federal Tax return and has proved to be a successful method, a very proper and legal fund raising with no strings attached. This amendment calls for a changing the form on the Nebraska Form income tax return to allow an individual or if it is a joint return the two parties to designate that a dollar will be taken from their taxes and paid to a fund for the party that they designate. It seems to me that if all of us are as concerned as we say, about wanting to clean up campaign financing and campaign contributions, this is an excellent way to do that and to accomplish this.
