CLERK: Lr123, will be inserted in the Journal and referred to the Executive Board.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: Read LB499A. Read Carpenter motion.

PRESIDENT: We are ready for your motion on the introduction of the bill.

CLERK: To suspend the rules and put into file your revisor bill.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is a bill that was brought to me by Mr. Wilson who is the head of the bill drafting department. It is strictly a revisor bill which everybody knows a what that is. He feels that it is necessary and I asked for the introduction of the bill. If Senator Duis....a....a..if it is introduced now, I'll attempt to put it at the head of General File, without a hearing.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of Senator Carpenter's motion to introduce the bill? Question is do you want to... Senator Kremer? Alright stand by. The question is do you want to suspend the rules....actually do you want to introduce the bill? All those in favor....the rules will have to be suspended and the question is do you want to suspend the rule for the introduction of the bill? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. This is a motion to suspend the rules for an introduction of the bill. That motion does require 30 votes. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: If the body doesn't want to introduce the bill, lets get on with something else to do. I have no desire on the bill one way or the other.

PRESIDENT: Alright Gentlemen, what is your pleasure? Senator Carpenter's motion to suspend the rules and introduce the bill. It requires 30 votes? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails to suspend the rules for the introduction of the bill. Are there other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Stand by for just a moment. Senator Kremer, for what purpose did you want to be recognized?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman as soon as it is dispensed with the material on the Clerk's desk, I would like to ask a question of the Chair.

PRESIDENT: Alright sir.

CLERK: This may take awhile.

PRESIDENT: Yean, you may be waiting all morning, but I do appreciate your patience.
