You are changing the agenda in a sense. All right, have you all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good. So ordered. The amendments will be printed. The bill is bracketed until Monday. Now gentlemen what is your pleasure regarding LB302. Senator Kennedy in the chamber. That bill was bracketed for today. Do you want to discuss it. What is your pleasure? Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: While we are waiting, Mr. President. Several of us would like transcript copies of Senator Duis' speech on hookers, if we might.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: As I told, Senator Lewis, only if it's in color.

CLERK: Mr. President, a message from the Governor (read) Mr. President, reports read. 719 advanced to General File

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, did you have some input on 302.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, Senator Stahmer is here now. He and Whitney and a bunch of us had a conference to this relative to laying it over until Thursday. And I'll let Senator Stahmer present it.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer. What is your please regarding the bill, Sir.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President. If I could I'd like to move at this time that we set this bill over until Thursday. There's been some amendments, and Senator Kennedy wanted Senator Whitney and I to look them over with our staff, Mr. Ehrlich and Doc Holder, and I think we can do that by Thursday. And this is not a stall, we want to move this bill Thursday.

PRESIDENT: Which Thursday.

SENATOR STAHMER: This coming Thursday.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Sir. Are there objections to laying the bill until this Thursday. Any objections? To laying 302 over. Hearing no objections. So ordered. The bill is laid over until Thursday. This to the head of General File. It looks like 875A. Senator Snyder do you want to pass over 875A.

SENATOR SNYDER: I'd ask unanimous consent to bracket that bill.

PRESIDENT: You want to bracket it?

SENATOR SNYDER: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder is asking unanimous consent to bracket 875A on General File. Are there objections to bracketing the bill? 875A. Speaker Proud.
