PRESIDENT: Thank you, we'll begin General File debate then this morning with, I think, LB953. General File debate will begin with LB953 and Clerk will read the Title if it hasn't already been read.

CLERK: Read LB953. The bill was first considered February 28 and laid over. There are committee amendments which were adopted. There are no further amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Kelly, what shall we do with the bill?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I think we should advance this bill or kill it. This is another one of the bills that attempt to pick up the child support payments that are delinquent. And to, in this case, allow counties to take subrogation to recover ADC payments that can be recovered. This bill was one of them that the people in the legal fraternity says is not properly written and that they said they would give full support to right or write amendments that would make this idea work. They have not done that. If you care to follow the work that is done by the Legislature's bill drafting office, you could vote to advance this bill. If you don't want to, vote to kill it.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the bill? Motion is to advance. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB953. Takes 25 votes. Have you all voted? Call. Senator Carpenter?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask if...the vote be announced. If they don't want to vote, why let's pass it over.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 4 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion loses. Next bill in line is LB499A. Clerk read the title.

CLERK: Read 499A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, what should we do with the bill?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move for the advancement of 499A to E & R Initial. Purpose of this bill is to fund the loan program for the Vietnam Veterans that you passed the other day. This is the loan appropriation, the A bill that goes along with it and we'll need to fund it so the act can take care of itself and give these Vietnam Veterans a loan. I so move for the advancement of LB499A.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Motion is to advance LB499A. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Voting aye, Vince.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.
