PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, will you yield to a question from Senator Nore?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Sir.

SENATOR NORE: Do we have any supervision of what's being taught in these day care centers?

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Nore, Day Care Centers have personalities just like any other business has personalities. There certainly are educational day care centers, but there are also just baby sitter day care centers. Now the mother of this child, will have a lot to say which type of facility she wants her child to attend, and the funds that are available. Now, the control of what goes on in that day care center is a direct responsibility of the State Welfare Department.

SENATOR NORE: Have you seen some of the documentary films on these day care centers in the east?

SENATOR KELLY: No, I have not.

SENATOR NORE: Well, you should, because it's real dangerous. Now I'm not opposing this, but I'm hoping, I won't be around here, but I'm hoping someone will take a good look, the parents would take a good look, and see what those kids are being indoctrinating with in these day care centers. This is a beautiful place for some of these outlaw organizations to infiltrate our youth.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, Senator Kelly. Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE : Mr. President, and members of the Legislature. The Clerk informs me that he can read this bill in about 45 seconds, and I think we have already wasted about 45 minutes in debate, we have 15 days left and I call for the question.
