Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 28 nays, 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion to return the bill has failed. We will now proceed with Final Reading of LB972.

CLERK: LB972 (read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, Shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Final passage of LB972. Once again the Chair would ask, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting aye 34, voting no 9, not voting 6 (Printed on page 1144-45 of Journal)

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. All right, now do we have any Resolutions?

CLERK: Mr. President, a communication from the Governor (read)

PRESIDENT: It is the Chair's understanding we next have a motion by Senator Marvel for the introduction of a couple of bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to suspend the...Mr. President I move the introduction of LB10, of a bill which will be known as 1053. I move for the introduction of a bill to appropriate funds.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: This is the first of about four bills that I will introduce today. This is the smaller operations budget. So I ask so the rules be suspended and we get the bill introduced. And then I will make another motion to put it ahead of General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator all we need is just a simple motion then to introduce the bill in this instance. All right, is there any further discussion of the motion. Are you all through discussing the motion. The question is, shall the bill be introduced. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise, Senator.

SENATOR CARPENTER: A point, can we introduce all three on the same motion, or will it take separate motions.

PRESIDENT: No.

SENATOR CARPENTER: You can't do it.

PRESIDENT: I would prefer not. Thank you, Sir. Have you all Voted? I suppose that the Chair should remind the body that it does take 30 votes to introduce the bill. Thank you. The Clerk will record.
