Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the bills are placed at the head of General File.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, I move to consider 1053 and 1054 on General File right after at 2:00.. I didn't catch what he said. At 2:00 Mr. President. Or right after lunch.

PRESIDENT: All right, after recess then, we will consider the bills. Those two bills on General File. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well now, I would like to also move that after these bill that Senator Marvel introduced. That all appropriation bills dealing with expenditure money follow them. I'd like to Say to Senator Dickinson, and others that this is moving pretty fast. I'm sure you don't understand what's in the bill, and if you have an objection to this, speed and this way we are going, I think you ought be consistent and object to it now. And not later.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes, you have heard the motion, that is that after we hear 1053 and 1054, that all appropriations bills follow in ~~the~~ order then, for discussion.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, all I'd like to know is, are these bills going to b e so that we can see them now, and get ahead of them. That's the one that just came out on the floor from Senator Marvel. Amazing is right, if that's right.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: May I respond. We have a charge that was given when we took...when the Legislature took two days off. So we started work. We have two bills, 1053 and 1054 for your consideration, now they are printed, and we also have the background on income projecti ons and the cost of the appropriations bills. Sometime this afternoon you will have worksheets on the capital construction bill, and also on the deficiency bill. And those bills are now being
