

SENATOR SYAS: Any organization, say there were four or five of us and we call ourselves for the protection of wild animals. Do we have to go through this same thing?

SENATOR WARNER: If you were to make yourself an organized group for the protection of wild animals and there was a campaign issue on the ballot that you wanted to collectively contribute as a group, you would be limited to one-thousand dollars to a candidate. You would not be limited if it was a proposition as the amendment was offered.

SENATOR SYAS: What proposition?

SENATOR WARNER: If the issue that you wish to contribute to dealt with a proposition on the ballot, such as a constitutional amendment, you would not be limited. If you wish on the other hand, to contribute to a candidate then your organization as a group would be limited to one thousand dollars although you could individually contribute up to a thousand dollars.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: What if there was a thousand people in this group?

SENATOR WARNER: If they wanted to make a collectively contribution to the a...a..they would be limited to a thousand dollars but there would be nothing that would prohibit each of them....

SENATOR SYAS: Could they in turn also as individuals after doing that give a thousand dollars?

SENATOR WARNER: Individually, and outside the group?

SENATOR SYAS: Yeah. You just say here is a thousand people and they are going...you are only allowed to contribute a thousand dollars. Alright now then...a...then they do it as singles.

SENATOR WARNER: Could.

SENATOR SYAS. Then they could contribute a thousand dollars singly on top of the....

SENATOR WARNER: On top of their one dollar as a group. A total of a thousand and one dollars.

SENATOR SYAS: Well I can buy that, that is a little bit better, don't wait for me to give a thousand dollars though, but...

SENATOR WARNER: The problem Senator Syas is that when you... if you have ...you either have a limitation or you don't. It seems as if we put one in, then everybody wants out from under it. Either we have one or we don't, were making one exception to that now for...relative to a proposition on the ballot that seemed to be the primary concern that was expressed the other day. But as far as individual candidates it would remain.

SENATOR SYAS: This will make it though, this will a...a..lid so to speak on the amount of people will make a constitutional amendment practically impossible?
