If you are in favor of the Rule change you will vote aye. If not, you will vote no. It takes 30 votes to adopt the Rules change. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are now voting on the Rule change as amended by Senator Stahmer, 30 votes are required. Now once again the Chair would inquire if you have all voted? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I would ask for a Call of the House, because we had one during debate. We lifted the call prior to the vote, so I would ask for a Call of the House at the present time.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the Clerk will record what we have presently on the board. Here we go again. The next bell please indicate your support of a Call of the House. This motion if I could have your attention is for a Call of the House. Thank you. Clerk will record. Read the results please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: WE are now under Call of the House. The next bell please indicate your presence. We are asking you to indicate your presence please, we are under Call of the House. The motion under vote is the Rule change, Senator Dickinson voting aye. Senator Carpenter changing from no to aye. We are under Call of the House. Senator Kelly voting aye. And the motion under vote is the Rule change offered by Senator Johnson through Senator Duis, which has been amended by Senator Stahmer. Voting no, Senator Luedtke voting no. Stand by, just a minute, Senator Johnson. Let's wait and give the Senators a chance to vote here. Every time we raise the call the SENATORS disappear and then we don't have what we think we have afterwards. That's a little hard for the Chair. Senator Burbach the issue under vote, do you understand the issue. You are voting aye. Senator Burbach aye. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: How many do you have?

PRESIDENT: I can't announce the Rules, I can't announce the votes etc. All right, the motion is to Raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes and 1 nay to Raise.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the Call is Raised Read the tally on the original vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 14 nays, 3 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the Rule change is adopted. Senator Duis for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, thank you gentlemen very much for going through this trying time. We had another rule that we were going to bring up today, which would have been advanced before the Legislature, with your kind permission we will forgo bringing it up today so that we might continue with General File and we can bring it up tomorrow.
