I commented to the cab driver on this and he explained to me that they were all whores. You see they looked real pretty but underneath they were prostitutes. If we pass this bill we will be prostituting ourselves to just get a few federal money and a few federal dollars and supposedly solve all of our child rearing for the future. As I say it is going to mean an increase in taxes, it is going to be an increase in your bureaucracy and maybe not this year, a year or two years, three years hence, I guess that I really can't think of any bill since I have been in this legislature which goes more directly to destruction of the family than this particular bill. It does it so quietly and so deceptively. You know that you can take a frog and if you put him...if you have a hot bucket of water and you drop the frog in the water you can't get him in that water because as soon as he hits it he will feel it and spring off. However you can take this same frog and put him in a cold bucket of water and slowly heat the water on a fire and the frog will sit there and he will let you boil him to death, because you are just gradually making him comfortable. Well this program goes in the same direction. The first three or four years when the federal government started bribing and black-mailing the states into doing everything that the federal government wanted whether it was wearing a helmet or having a meat inspection or having a new ambulance program or passing this or passing that for fear of losing funds, we had to be ordered. The state rebelled just a little bit. Now the pot is warm, the frog is accustomed to being ordered around by the federal government and we are just about to be boiled. Now Senator Chambers said this morning about the love of children, that anyone who was opposed to this really didn't care about children. Well Senator Chambers I love children and I think that they should be raised by families and mothers and that is why, I'm wasting your time, I know that you feel that way, bringing the bill back and hoping that it would be eliminated. If it is not eliminated, if it is not destroyed then it should be amended to get things under control. There are no controls under this bill. The only thing that is in the bill is five or four million dollars for someone to go and set up their own concept of how children should be raised I urge you to at least bring the bill back. If you don't want to kill it lets amend it but lets not allow this to go into effect then at this time. We would be giving up several million dollars in federal funds, but we would also be saving a million dollars in state money, but that is very minor compared to the fact that we would be saving the integrity of the family.
