

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, if we unbracket this bill does that mean that it goes ahead of the bills that are underlined up there that the Senators have set as their preference?

PRESIDENT: For next Tuesday? Yes sir, it does.

SENATOR KEYES: Well then, I'll ask this questions. Is it proper right now, is it proper to entertain a motion to indefinitely postpone 651?

PRESIDENT: No, because the bill isn't up for discussion. This is only a motion to unbracket 651.

SENATOR KEYES: Well lets bring it up for discussion and let indefinitely postpone it and get it out of the way.

PRESIDENT: Well, we can't do it now Senator Keyes, but I understand your movement there. Senator Stull did you want to be heard on the motion to unbracket 651 and set it up for next Tuesday? Alright any further discussion of the motion? Senator Waldron do you have any closing on the motion. Senator Syas, for what purpose do you rise Senator?

SENATOR SYAS: I rise to take acception to the motion. Where is the bill right now?

PRESIDENT: My understanding is that it is...

CLERK: It is bracketed indefinitely in General File.

SENATOR SYAS: Bracketed indefinitely. Alright I'm going to take exception to it. I think that Senator Keyes is right. On General File is one thing and on Select File is another. I think that Senator Keyes is right that we should follow General File in their order and that each Senator has up there or will have the bill that he wants and I think that they should come ahead of this one. I mean if we are going to honor 49 requests which will probably be, how can we take up the 49 requests and take another one out of bracket that...that doesn't deserve it. If we start that, what I am getting at, you are going to start (mike turned off) with their special bill each one 49 isn't going to take it at all.

PRESIDENT: I suppose that the way for the Chair to resolve this particular question and in that the priority keeps shifting back and forth and the Chair is not involved in this or determining that priority other than what this body determines here. Right now the issue before this body is shall LB651 be unbracketed and set for next Tuesday. Now then what you want to decide is the next question and so forth if that bill next Tuesday takes priority over the 49 underlined presumably underlined bills. I can't then decide that issue at this time. I don't think that would be right for the Chair to try and decide that issue.

SENATOR SYAS: Then I motion that the 49 come ahead of his.

PRESIDENT: Fine, lets see if that...that is really right, it is a conflict under to state certain business. He is trying to bracket a bill for discussion on a day sir.

SENATOR SYAS: What is that, I didn't hear you?
