PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. There are many things that we catch at the last minute. We can't condemn these people for finding this out but they do feel that they need this badly and if it does affect the cities and the villages, I think we should give it to them.

PRESIDENT: All right, are you all through discussing now? Senator Lewis, are you through closing? Fine and dandy. The question is, do you want to return LB1024 to Select File for a specific amendment? This is to return the bill only. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. 25 votes are necessary to return the bill to Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 5 nays to return.

PRESIDENT: Okay, the bill's returned. We'll take up the amendment to it when we get to Select File. Do we have Resolutions that need attention?

CLERK: We have a motion, Mr. President, to place LR and something on the file. Mr. President, to place LRI28 on General File. Signed, Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Stand by. Is Senator Carpenter in the chamber? Senator Mahoney, do you....possibility that you want to handle this or do you know about it?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I request that this Resolution be placed in, on top of General File and be taken up today.

PRESIDENT: At the top of General File to be handled today?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, I don't know what the Resolution is about so before I let anything go to the top of General File, I'm going to find out.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, I think.....

CLERK: This is LRI28 which was put in yesterday. It's on page 1184 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, let's let them take a look at them and see what they want to do, Senator Mahoney. It wasn't a unanimous consent, Senator Luedtke, it was just a motion, yeah, so you get to vote on it, debate it. Now, Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The issue before the Body now is the motion which....wait a minute.....LB....LRI28 on General File at the head of General File.
