There are some opinion that we can't do it without a constitutional change. I don't agree but that doesn't have anything to do without or with what we're talking about. If we believe in that and I do, I think we ought to do the same thing to this resolution to put it on the Ballot. It's a highly important thing in which there's probably some difference of opinion. What I'm trying to say, let's take Kearney for example, I'm sure that Kearney, at least the people in Kearney, would like to have that normal....

school become a part of the University complex. I think in order to do that we ought to give the same, if we can legally do it, the same option to the other three schools. I think they ought to take it. They may or may not and in order to make sure that we can do these things, I think we ought to pass this resolution, the one coming up which will be submitted tomorrow, and put it on the Ballot the same way. So I want to indicate now that I have two things in mind and not bring another one up and not alert you to what I have an interest in and others have a like interest.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, the motion before the House is to suspend the rules and actually to place the resolution at the head....excuse me, on General File. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I strenuously object to placing LR128 at the head of General File. We have other bills which others of the senators in this Body consider important. We have a procedure to follow. I would urge the Body to follow our own procedure and let's get to the budget bills soon.

PRESIDENT: Senator, I may have confused things because it was Senator Mahoney who made the motion that it would go to the head of General File. He has withdrawn that motion. We have only Senator Carpenter's motion before us which is just to place LR128 on the General File. That's the only issue, before the Body at this time. Now, Speaker Proud.

SPEAKER PROUD: Well, I would only urge and, of course, you probably won't follow this, I would urge everyone to quit talking about this and let's vote. We're never going to get to General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer. Passing? Senator Carpenter, discussion. Question is, do you want to suspend the rules and place LR128....Senator Skarda?

SENATOR SKARDA: Mr. President and members of the Body. I think this is a highly important issue and I spent a considerable amount of my time in meeting every other year and now we're into the area where we meet every year and I'd much rather go back to meeting every other year and I...there's gentlemen in this Body who I have a lot of respect for and I think you can make a determination. The sum is if there's a question in your mind so I'm going to direct a question to Senator Marvel and I hope that he asks us, which do you prefer, to meet every year or every other year and why.
