SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Are there amendments on those?

CLERK: 826A, yes.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to 826A.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB826A on Select File. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move LB826A as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now there is a motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor for advancement of the bill please say aye. Thank you. The Clerk....oh, all those opposed. So ordered, the bill's advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB1028.

PRESIDENT: You've now heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB1028 on Select File. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move LB1028 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now the motion is to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye. I heard no ayes. Thank you. All those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill's advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB1024 has a specific amendment by Senator F. Lewis, for which the bill.....

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator F. Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I think I can clarify this just a little bit for you, if you'll look at the bill LB1024. We are simply restoring language that was deleted. If you look at Section 2 on Page 3, the language says "any of the officers referred to in Sub-section 1 of this section which refers to officers," (I will, Wally) "except for members of the Board of Public Works may be removed at the pleasure by a vote of the majority of all members of the Council with the approval of the Mayor" which is the same language which we are re-inserting although cleaning it up a little bit and we're simply saying that these officers may be removed at any time by the mayor with the approval of the majority of the Council. This is no language...there is no structural change in the present way it's being done. All of the officers referred to in this sub-section must have the approval of the Council. I'd hate for us to make much ado about nothing, I think it's a simple corrective amendment and I move for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the motion? All right then, the motion is do you want to adopt this specific amendment to LB1024 on Select File. If so, vote aye. If not, vote no. You're voting on the specific amendment to LB1024 on Select File as offered by Senator F. Lewis. Well, let's see here....there we go. Well, vote again and let's see if we can get the totals up here. I think we're okay.
