SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Waldron is asking for a Call of the House. The Clerk will record and clear the board. Thank you. At the next bill, please indicate your support of a Call of the House. Senator Waldron is asking for a Call of the House. Please indicate your support of a Call of the House. You can still vote. You want to vote no on the original issue? Well, stand by, we don't have a call and I can't take call in votes unless we get a Call of the House. We haven't gone under Call here yet, hold on. This motion is for a Call of the House, have you all voted? Motion is for Call of the House. I'm waiting for you to vote.

SENATOR WALDRON: I ask for a Roll Call vote, Mr. President, I see we're not going to get a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right, wait a minute, record the...yes, sir, record the vote.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 19 nays, for Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Call of the House fails. Senator Waldron has asked for a Roll Call vote.

CLERK: The motion is to return LB327. Senator Anderson. (Clerk takes Roll Call vote). (Found on page 1212 of Journal).

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise? Voting aye? Senator Barnett voting aye. 20 ayes, 24 nays.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 24 nays.

PRESIDENT: The motion to return the bill fails. Do we have other motions? For Select File?

CLERK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Before we get to the next motion, the Chair is pleased to announce that we have 34 seniors and 1 exchange student from the American Government class of Tobias, Nebraska. They're from Senator Maresh's district. Instructor is Mr. Don Leeks. They're seated in the south balcony and we're delighted to have you here today as spectators to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. We hope you enjoy your visit to the Capital City. Sometimes I observe it sure beats going to school. All right, do we have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB821, there is pending a specific amendment inserted in the Journal for which Senator Stull now asks permission to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stull for his motion.

SENATOR STULL: What I want to do is withdraw this amendment and substitute another one. The problem with my original amendment, the bill doesn't go into effect as, it has a delayed effective date and I want my amendments to go into effect at once. Now, I don't know whether Senator Dickinson is ready to bring this back or not at this time. I think we'll lay it over until tomorrow but I would like to withdraw this one amendment.
