CLERK: Mr. President, we have some committee reports, your committee on Enrollment Review reports they have examined and reviewed LB960, recommend it be replaced on Select File as amended. LB861 replaced on Select File as amended. LB692 replaced on Select File as amended. Signed, John Cavanaugh, Chairman. Mr. President, we have a motion. I move to withdraw LB520, signed, Senator Luedtke. The motion should properly lay over.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move, Mr. President, there is pending a motion to withdraw LB880 by Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Kennedy in the chamber?

CLERK: I think he's at that meeting, Mr. President. I'm sorry, it's Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly. It's not Senator Kennedy. Senator Kelly, we have your motion to withdraw what...LB880?

CLERK: Senator Kelly is moving to withdraw LB880. It was done a couple days ago and the motion has been laid over. He asked to replace on that spot on General File LB754.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, you're asking to substitute LB754 in its place. You can talk on that but the Chair's going to rule this is going to involve two motions. So, you can withdraw LB880 and then you can try, you can test the water on your idea regarding LB754. But I can't, I don't think I can accept it as part of the same motion. It's a divisible question, I'm sure. Senator Kelly, back to you.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. The reason for this request is the time saving, easy move up proposition. If LB880 stays where it is and it comes up for debate, I'm sure that Senator Carpenter and I would attempt to get your permission to take the language out of LB880 and substitute into it the language of LB754 which has to do with the motor vehicle licensing board. But we'd have \$300 worth of printing, etc., etc., if we just move LB880 out of the way, put LB754 there with just a simple motion, we could accomplish the same thing. That voluminous amendments if you would approve them would accomplish by leaving LB880 in the store.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, the Chair might be criticized for doing this but let's see what would happen on this one. What about the possibility of a unanimous consent to just at this time switch LB754 with LB880 and see what happens on that and then we'll go from that point. Do you want to try that?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, that would be fine, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Kelly is asking unanimous consent to switch LB754 with LB880 with the intent that he's going to withdraw LB880 and so this time he is asking unanimous consent now. Are there objections to that? Senator Syas, do you object? Yes or no?

SENATOR SYAS: Can I make a statement and ask a question.

PRESIDENT: Yes, you can, I will allow that.
