CLERK: 23 ayes, 4 nays, to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: Very good. We're under a Call of the House. At the next bell, please indicate your presence. We are now under a Call of the House. The question under vote is the return of LB1028....we are under Call of the House and the question is the return of LB1028 to Select File for a specific amendment as offered by Speaker Proud and the vote is to return the bill only. That's all we're voting on at this time is the return of LB1028. Senator Lewis voting aye. Excuse me, Senator F. Lewis voting aye. And Senator Epke voting aye.

CLERK: Senator F. Lewis voting aye. Senator Epke voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Motion under vote is the return of LB1028. Senator R. Lewis voting aye.

CLERK: Senator R. Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers voting no.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wiltse voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Wiltse voting aye.

PRESIDENT: All right. Speaker Proud. Thank you. Speaker Proud has moved the Call be raised. All those in favor of raising the Call vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Motion is to raise the Call. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. Read the tally of the original vote now. Do we have the tally.....?

CLERK: 22 ayes, 11 nays, 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Okay, LB1028 is returned to Select File. Senator Proud, do you want to make your motion? Speaker Proud.

SPEAKER PROUD: I move the amendment be adopted. It's been discussed.

PRESIDENT: Are you all through discussing the amendment? Then the question is, Senator Carpenter?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Roll Call vote.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter is asking for a Roll Call vote on the amendment to LB1028. All right. Roll Call vote. You are now voting on the Proud specific amendment to LB1028 on Select File.

CLERK: Roll Call vote. (Found on page 1219 of Journal). 32 ayes, 10 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The specific amendment is adopted. Speaker Proud.
