SENATOR CARPENTER: What do you mean elected to another office?

But the fact is, I think there is a significant body of opinion in this Legislature that agrees that unless we deal with these two bills, we're going to have havoc in the office of Lieutenant Governor and Governor. And, therefore, I agree completely with Senator Syas that everyone here who is interested in the race for Lieutenant Governor or Governor except Senator Chambers, should want to see those two bills advanced. Now Senator Chambers thinks he's got a good lawsuit either way but if you were to get into the innermost part of his clever mind, I think he might agree it would even be better if we don't pass these two bills. The point is, they deserve action and we ought to get to it.

PRESIDENT: All right. There is nothing before the Body at this time and we're still on Select File. Senator Stahmer, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, I would just like to point out what's so bad about having utter havoc in the Lieutenant Governor's office. We've got other havoc here.
