SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move LE782 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now, the motion is to advance LB782 as amended. All those in favor of the advancement please say aye. Those opposed say no. Ayes have it. So ordered, the bill's advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB1028.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB1028. All those in favor of that motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move LB1028 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now you've heard the motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancement of LB1028 say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill's advanced. We have LB821, I think. It was returned from....

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB821.

PRESIDENT: Stand by just a moment.

CLERK: LB821 has no E & R amendments. It was returned this morning for a specific amendment offered, I believe, by Senator Stull, Mr. President. The motion was first returned for.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Stull for his motion on LB821. Let's hold down the confusion here.

SENATOR STULL: This amendment that I offer to LB821 is lengthy and it is eight pages long but all it does, in four places where it refers to an operators license, it adds "or permit". And in three places where it says "motor vehicle", it adds "or motorcycle". And then where it refers to the person holding the valid license riding with someone with a learner's permit, it adds "in case of a motorcycle, he shall sit immediately behind the one holding the learner's permit." Now, that's all it does but it takes eight pages to actually do the job. I move the adoption of my amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of Senator Stull's amendment to LB821 on Select File? All right, then the question is, do you want to adopt the amendment? All of those in favor of adoption of the amendment vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You are adopting Senator Stull's eight page amendment...to LB821 on Select File. Keep cool, Senator Stull, keep cool. Have you all voted? Okay, Clerk will record....
