PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I held this motion off the desk until I could see how the other one was disposed of. I'm going to make a motion that LB034, the ADC bill be moved to the top of General File for immediate consideration. I have talked to some of the members already and because of the fact that the Governor is for this and various members of the body said that they are for it and I think that it ought to be considered for certain this session. The budget bill is there, I don't know if that will occur, that is the reason for this motion and I hope that we can get the votes to do so....how many votes will it take to do this? It would take 30 votes?

PRESIDENT: Stand by Senator Chambers just a moment. Thank you Senator Chambers our delay now is....Senator Chambers the Chair is going to concur that in order for you to do this it is going to take a suspension of the rules, because we already have a line up of appropriation bills which were placed there by another motion and that is at the head. So go for your suspension of the rules and see what happens. Senator Stahmer, did you want to debate the Chambers...

SENATOR STAHMER: No, I just want to support him and lets take a vote on it. I think that Senator Chambers has the votes.

PRESIDENT: Now then, any further discussion? Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, it is a rule of order here that this is an appropriation bill and it requires the appropriation of money and it follows after the other appropriation money in that like order. Not a change in this thing now I am opposed to it and I object. Now if you want to kill all of these bills I will help you. I will slow this thing down to a crawl.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy then Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would like to say too that I think that 977 is also more or less of a companion bill and if we were to consider this we ought to consider 977 at the same time. I would make that amendment.
