PRESIDENT: Legislature please come to order. We will have roll call. Please indicate your presence. Clerk will record. Read the results. Announce the results please.

CLERK: Quorum present.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do we have any notices of committee hearings.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have an Attorney General's opinion that will be in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a unanimous consent request to advance the bills on General and on Select File (Signed) Senator Carpenter. There is only three of them.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the E & R amendments be adopted.

CLERK: 960, my apology, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB960, all those in favor of adopting the amendments, please say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced from E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance LB960 as amended, all those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: 821.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB821. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that 821 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: And now the subject in motion is that 821 be advanced as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say, those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: 782.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB782. All those in favor of that motion, please say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.
