PRESIDENT: The Chair needs a motion for you to reject the committee amendments, Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I so move, to reject the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, is there any further discussion. Senator Kelly, do you want to be heard on the rejection of the committee amendments. Thank you. Senator Goodrich. Question is do you want to reject the committee amendments. If you do vote aye, if not vote no. This the motion to reject the committee amendments. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the committee amendments are rejected. Senator Kelly back to you. We are now debating the movement of 977.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. We know this is a good bill, we think 834 is a gooder one, but Let's call the question and vote.

PRESIDENT: Are you all through discussing. The question is, now do you want to advance LB977. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, all those opposed vote no. We are advancing LB977, if you want to get in on the act this is the time to vote. Read the total.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: LB 977 is advanced. Now, Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. Speaker, I would ask that this bill also be advanced expeditiously.

PRESIDENT: So ordered. The bill will be expedited. Now, Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Have it understood that this bill will follow the other bill on Final Reading, and then whoever wants to, if they so desire then can bracket 977 until we find out what he wants to do with the other bill.

PRESIDENT: I now move to the General File consideration of LB1053.

CLERK: How about 977A. Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me. 997A.

CLERK: 977A (read)

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I move 977A be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: Do you need to discuss the motion. The question is, shall 977A be advanced. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
