SENATOR HASEBROOCK: No, I think it's been pretty well discussed. And I will certainly try to get the..any information and get it passed around on the desks to all the members as to what.. how they intend to allocate the funds. And I move that the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock has moved that his amendment be adopted. This requires 25 votes. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. We are voting on the Hasebroock amendment. The motion requires 25 votes have you all voted?

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: I will have to ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: A call of the house has been requested. The clerk will clear the board. The question is, shall there be a Call of the House. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. We are voting on the Hasebroock amendment. Clerk will record the vote on the Call of House.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. Sergeant of Arms please round up the rest of the members. Record the presence.

CLERK: Senator Luedtke voting on the original motion. Senator Goodrich voting aye.

PRESIDENT: House is under Call, please take your seats. We are voting on Senator Hasebroock motion. An amendment to the Budget bill requires 25 votes. Senator Duis voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye. Senator Kennedy voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Voting on the Burbach amendment. House under Call.

CLERK: two more.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will have to ask you to take your seats. Senator Hasebroock will you please take your seat. SENator Hasebroock will you please take your seat. I don't mind a little (inaudible) but this is going too far. Did you call your vote SENator Keyes. House is under Call. Senator Keyes for what purpose do you rise. Senator Simpson voting aye. Just to know what ...

SENATOR KEYES: Just to know what we are spending the money for. You know, a fellow votes for that much money, he would like to know what's it for. I just walked in. The Burbach amendment sounds good. He was back to explain it to me, and we ordered him out. Hasebroock, I thought it was your campaign fund.

PRESIDENT: SENator Hasebroock, did you move to raise the call. Motion is made for the Call to be Raised. Clerk will clear the board. All those in favor to Raise the call vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, to Raise the call.

PRESIDENT: The call is Raised. The Clerk will now read the vote on the original motion.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays on the original motion. Amendment is adopted.
