PRESIDENT: Recognize Senator Marvel on the committee amendment. Senator Nore, would you turn off your light please.

SENATOR MARVEL: Would you read the amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: On page 24, line, insert after the, or before the semi-colon 'state aid bridge fund'

SENATOR MARVEL: This is simply a technical amendment that was not put in when the bill was drawn. That's all it is. But we will have to have 25 votes to approve it. So I so move the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion. If not the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. VOTING aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.

PRESIDENT: The motion is a committee amendment, which takes 25 votes. Have you all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nay, 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Further amendments on the desk. This section?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Then we will go to Senator Marvel on the bill.

SENATOR MARVEL: Now, is it agreed now that we can pass the bill over and whatever amendments there are can be put on in Select File. I don't want to push fast, this isn't the desire of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: I think you can make the motion, Senator Marvel, and then if anyone wants to discuss it, they can discuss it.

SENATOR MARVEL: O.K. I move that LB 1053 be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: All right. All right, discussion. Does Senator Carpenter wish to discuss that motion.

SENATOR CARPENTER: No, I would just like to have Senator Marvel explain Section 20, on page 26. This is a highly important amendment. It was put in lb997 in the exact terminology as this is.
