PRESIDENT: I believe the motion as it is right now does not apply to bracketed bills, because it says those below six... that is it..676..677. So it would just apply to those below 677 and it wouldn't apply to bracketed bills. Senator Goodrich did you want to say something.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, we have a little problem that the Legislature should decide what they..one way or the other. We've got two bills remaining in the rest of General File. I haven't been able to spot the second one yet, but 1051 for example, and 795 are bills if we do not adopt, placed us in jeopardy with federal highway funds, and I think the Legislature ought to decide whether or not we're going to let those bills go down the tube and take the chance of the federal funds, or whether we are going to...

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, whose was...whose bill are you talking about.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, 1051 is the...

PRESIDENT: I don't want to know what it is about, I want to know whose it is.

SENATOR GOODRICH: It's public health. 1051.

PRESIDENT: Then they could be underlined if anybody wants to take it. Do you want to take it.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I've already got an underlined...

PRESIDENT: That's what I thought.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I'm just trying to call the body's attention to the fact that these are two of the bills that if we don't take care of them this session, we're placing federal funds in jeopardy and the only thing. It's your decision to make, I don't care one way or the other, it's just that it's your decision to make.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney. You had your light on, Senator Whitney. Did you want to be heard.

SENATOR WHITNEY: I'd like to ask Senator Carpenter a question, please.

PRESIDENT: Would you yield to a question, Senator Carpenter. Senator Carpenter do you yield to a question? Senator Carpenter do you yield to a question?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Carpenter, I presume this means any bills also that are in committee. Your motion would include that wouldn't it?
