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appropriations committee met on several occasions and the Chairman of the two respective committees met to work out these programmatic approaches to corrections. So the Judiciary Committee, the Advisory Committee on Criminal Justice, that is the Judiciary Committee, agrees wholeheartedly with this approach. As Senator Marvel indicates however, the only difference is with respect to LB1055 and what we do with the other..the second part of our correctional reform and our correctional modernization program. Senator Marvel would you yield to a question.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: On page 25, lines 19 to 21 where you are specifically referring in the bill to the fact that the Department of Correctional Services shall develop a statewide correctional service plan. Is this not the plan as submitted to the 83rd Legislature, 1st Session, by the Nebraska Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Advisory Committee. Namely, the comprehensive reports by the Judiciary Committee.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think this is part of it, Senator Luedtke. But I'm not certain.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Is this not the implementation of that plan. That's what I'm saying.

SENATOR MARVEL: It's the implementation and expansion, I think we'd say.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: If there is any doubt about that, then I would like to submit an amendment to say that it is the plan that's submitted to the 83rd Legislature because the Judiciary Committee did submit just this kind of a plan, and we are very grateful to the appropriations committee for implementating it with this kind of programmatic approach.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think we also try to emphasize here the fact that the Department of Corrections shouldn't rest on their laurels and indicate that they shouldn't continue to upgrade the plan. That they say, ok here's a plan, now we don't know have to do anymore. Because, You know I also set in on some of the hearings of your committee and listened to the..to the disagreement or lack of comment on the part of some of the correction officials. Therefore, I think what we are doing in addition to emphasizing your plan is also to needle those officials to keep moving in this area.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Absolutely. And thank you, Senator Marvel. And I agree that's what is necessary. And if it's understood that that's what is the intent of this bill is to include the plan as submitted by the 83rd Legislature 1st Session by the Nebraska Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Advisory Committee, I will not offer such an amendment. I think it's legislative intent by our discussion here on the floor, if that's agreeable to you. Thank you.
