I can guess for you. But I can't give you an adequate answer because they don't have the information at hand and that's one thing we propose that they do, is to come up with these answers and we give them the tools so they have no excuse for not coming with the answers. It's a good question which they should be able to answer, and I think we'll be able to answer if they impact of this bill goes through.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: How much money are we putting into this study?

SENATOR MARVEL: I'll get you the information in just a second. Do you have another question?

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Well, my point is, if we are really going to look at that. And really do something about it. And really solve some of the problems that are in the state colleges. And I think know what two or three of them are. I think we are going to have to have a massive study, and I'm not really overly impressed with the self study. I'm almost to the point to believe that let's have an external study somewhere. Do you have a comment, Senator

SENATOR MARVEL: Well included in the improvement funds for the state college system as roughly is \$82,591 for this.
