PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. We're ready to move the bill. Those in favor, we'll take a voice vote, of advancing LB826 say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill's advanced. Next bill's LB834A.

CLERK: There are no amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Cavanaugh here? Somebody else move the bill. Senator Luedtke? Senator Cavanaugh's coming. The motion is to advance LB834A. The motion is to advance LB834A. Voice vote, those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The bill's advanced. Next bill LB897.

CLERK: There are amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: LB877. LB897.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB897.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments, the E & R amendments. Those in favor say aye. Opposed. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move LB897 as amended be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB897. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The bill's advanced. Now, on LB877 there are amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB877.

PRESIDENT: Those in favor of the question say aye. Opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move LB877 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB877. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The bill's advanced.

CLERK: All right now, Mr. President, LB1053, the E & R amendments have been adopted. The bill was laid over. There are a series of amendments on the bill. The first one is offered by Senator Carpenter. It was printed in the Journal, it's on page 1296.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Carpenter in the room?

CLERK: Well, then there's another one, Mr. President. The next one is offered by Senator Carpenter but the next one after that is offered by Senator Richendifer. This is printed and appears on page 1298 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Are you ready to take up the amendment, Senator? You ready to take up the amendment, Senator Richendifer? Is a very long amendment?
