

are projects that are built in 1968 and including 1974. Then in the one-year program are those roads that are indicated with a square. Now if you will see, and you look at this map, there are many areas that have these roads and there are many, many more areas that...I'm sorry I can not tell you what is in the six year plan, how many miles of roads that are under consideration, but this is extremely important that these roads are built and that they are scattered across the state, in your various districts and they are not at the Lewis and Clark area only, they are other places in the state and there are other roads that need this completion. Now I do know that some of the roads in the state on the access roads to recreational areas are also built with federal aid money. Money that the county has and they put into various roads, or they also contribute. I know that is the case from Highway 12 to Santee, and if it is the case there I know it is in many other areas of the state. I move for the adoption of the amendment so that we can further this cause and build those roads to recreational areas.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: I would like to ask Senator Burbach a question. Senator Burbach, how much money is in the fund now, to build these roads in the park and recreational area and have we built all of the roads that the fund is there for? I understand that there is money there that hasn't been spent for the last several years.

SENATOR BURBACH: I do not know the exact dollar and cents of that fund today I don't have the booklet with me. I'm sorry. But the money is being spend. It was held up several years ago, but as of currently, it is all being spend. There are limitations for the spending, now the parks and game commission who are in charge of this responsibility they have adopted a one and a five year plan, or a six year plan total. In this coming year all of the money is ear-marked or obligated for construction this summer so there is nothing in the fund now Senator Keyes. Only that money which is obligated and ear-marked.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Burbach, then this money will come out of the highway fund. That will mean that the cities and the county will loose five hundred thousand dollars out to those various..... In other words, half of the funds go to the state and half go to the county. Now is this coming out of the state funds or is it coming out of the county and city funds?

SENATOR BURBACH: Could I defer that question to Senator Warner, he probably...at moment I am at loss for words as to answer you directly, but I am sure that Senator Warner can.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, do you care to respond.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Warner, I'll try to explain what I mean. The million dollars that Senator Burbach is talking about putting into the recreational area roads, does that come out of the state that goes to the state, or does that come out of the money that is going to the counties and cities?

SENATOR WARNER: It depends upon how the amendment is drafted, but
