SENATOR BURABCH: I don't know...

SENATOR KEYES: We are at a loss. We are spending a million dollars and don't know where we are taking it from.

SENATOR BURBACH: I do know now, Eldon Ehrlich just came over and told me that I had him draft this amendment for me, and this comes from the state portion, not from the county and city portion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes, are you through? Senator Burbach are you still responding to Senator Keyes?

SENATOR BURBACH: Senator Keyes, the dollar and cents figure I will have for you, they are calling in for it right now, how much of the fund. However, as I indicated before, it is all obligated for this construction year.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members of the legislature, Senator Burbach, if we were to adopt the amendment and I'm not speaking either for or against it, what kind of assurance could you give us that the highway department would be ready to have the plans made to build these roads? Or would this money just possibly sit there?

SENATOR BURBACH: There aren't many roads being built. I think that it is seven or eight and I do know that on the drawing board of the Game Commission the five year program would lend itself to this for the construction of those roads. They do have this program set up into the future.

SENATOR STAHMER: Perhaps I heard the Clerk wrong, but I thought that the page number cited for the Journal, it is not in my book. Several Senators around me made the same comment. I would like to suggest that we hold this matter over. I do not want to vote or speak against it with the knowledge that I know have and I think that we could hold this bill on Select File, and so that we could take a look at this if you would not object, Senator Burbach, overnight.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Could I ask the clerk a question. Well this is in the Journal is that right Mr. Clerk?
