SENATOR CARPENTER: Well it is your own fault if you don't. Now let me ask the chairman of the budget committee. Do you recommend this amendment?

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel do you care to respond?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now, would it be true for example that if we pass this amendment that we take..

PRESIDENT: Proceed Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Carpenter I might indicate to you that I am standing up here day after day I have the same problem when it comes to budget matters.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I realize Senator your position, you are trying to operate this state at a lower figure than the Governor of the state of Nebraska is. You are having some difficulties.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now the question is that if we pass this amendment, we take the million dollars out of the twenty million surplus, and we give it to the Games and Park Commission so we are already starting the pork mill process if you approved 100% five minutes ago. That is all that I wanted to call your attention too.
