

SENATOR SCHMIT: That is alright with me.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well what I mean is that if pass these two bills and send them to the Governor and he signs them in my judgment because they are passed after the other bill they will automatically supercede 834. I don't think that the body wants to do that.

SENATOR SCHMIT: No.

SENATOR CARPENTER: So, I would presume that if we bracket the bill, lets determine that question in his motion, with the understanding that will leave it bracketed and hope that it dies a natural death.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members of the body, I would like to ask Senator Schmit why he doesn't amend his motion to just kill LB977 and 977A.

PRESIDENT: He can't because we are not on Final Reading. He can move to bracket it but not to kill it. It is an action on the bill. Are you all through discussing the bracketing of the bill? Question is do you want to bracket the bills on Final Reading? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to bracket 977-977A on Final Reading. Motion is just to bracket. Chair would rule that the motion would take 25 votes. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the bill is bracketed.

CLERK: Read motions, correction the Government committee who has referred 476 has instructed me to report the same indefinitely postponed. Appointments found on page 1344 of the Journal and following there are several pages of them.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, there are 10 men here that have been appointed by the Governor and are up for consideration. I would like since no one appeared against any single one of these persons, I would like to ask unanimous consent that we take them all up at the same time. I'll list their names so that you will know who they are. Carlin Whitesell, Ronald J. Mertens, Richard L. DeBacker, Herman A. Brockmeier, Herbert G. Andrews, Walter R. Louis, Everett A. Lillich, Richard Dugdale, Hugh Riley and Bryan Quigley. I ask unanimous consent to take them all up.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney asking unanimous consent to take up all of the confirmation...to confirm all of the appointments at once. Are there objections to the confirmation in one motion? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Proceed Senator Whitney.
