

public institutions which basically has to do with the discussion that we had the other day in reference to regional centers and in reference to community mental health centers.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy, do you want to discuss the amendment?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I have a question for Senator Marvel. Senator Marvel just to clarify in the amendment that I was handed by your staff people the other day, for the Norfolk regional center we had as I understand it a total sum of two million, nine hundred and three thousand five hundred. We now in your amendment are talking about 1,981,500 now are we subtracting some of the federal funds as I understand your amendment leaves out the federal funds so that we won't have a misunderstanding here. I think that we are talking about the total of the same which will eventually be then 2,903,500.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir, the amount attributable in this case on page 3 of the Norfolk Regional Center of a 1,981,500 dollars is general fund money and the federal funds and the cash funds that are generated at Norfolk would stay at Norfolk. This just simply ties down the general fund.

SENATOR KENNEDY: That was my understanding but I did have an amendment that would the total would be different and I didn't want a misunderstanding here on the floor or with someone in the newsmedia or something that we are talking about the same thing in total which would be \$2,903,500. Thank you Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? Then the question is do you want to adopt the amendment which encompasses Senator Stahmer, excuse me.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, since I just got a copy of the amendment now, I wonder if we could pass over this and take up some of the other amendments then we could come back to this later on in the discussion?

PRESIDENT: Well it is your pleasure.

SENATOR MARVEL: It is alright with me, I would make...if Senator Stahmer wants to look it over that is fine. The other...there are two other amendments that we might go over briefly starting on page six through it starts with subdivision fourteen and goes through subdivision seventeen on page seven which has to do with specific amounts and I think that Senator Stahmer, you have incorporated these in the various state colleges for womens athletics.

PRESIDENT: Lets see we had better dispose of the other motion here. He, Senator Stahmer is asking...for..

SENATOR MARVEL: I would ask for unanimous consent, in a..a.. Senator Stahmer that the original amendment that I posed be held up temporarily. To be withdrawn is the easiest way to do it.
