PRESIDENT: The Chair would agree that these two as written here Senator Kelly and so forth, I don't think that we can divide this one. Those two figures are interrelated here in this amendment so you are either going to have to oppose the amendment vote it up or down however you choose, but that is the way that it is here. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: If these two figures the 15 and 25 if they are interrelated, they certainly would be spend for the same program then.

SENATOR GOODRICH: No, no. What we are saying Senator Kelly is that we would have to rewrite section two of the amendment to split out the 15,000 and split out the 25,000 and adjust the other figures that you have to adjust as totals to do that.

PRESIDENT: Alright, we have a motion to recess. What other business do we have on the desk.

CLERK: Read E & R report. Read unanimous consent report. regarding 651, the unanimous consent? We...

PRESIDENT: Motion is to unbracket 651? Where is it at? Senator Rasmussen is asking unanimous consent to unbracket 651. Oh, bracket it on general file. Are there objections to unbracketing the bill? Hearing none, so ordered. We will bracket the bill.
