PRESIDENT: We would like to have you indicate your presence please. The Chair is looking for a quorum. Have you indicated your presence? Clerk will record. Thank you. We will stand by until we can corner a quorum. I bet you can't say that 3 times straight. Roll Call. Please indicate your presence. Have you all indicated your presence? Once again have you all indicated your presence. All right fine, Clerk will record. And the results are? Pardon me. All right, we are still short a quorum. Stand by. Thank you.

CLERK: Quorum present.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, what announcements do we have.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is pending the Goodrich amendment to LB1054.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Marsh. We are discussing the Goodrich amendment to LB1054.

SENATOR MARSH; And the other 24 members who are currently on the floor.

PRESIDENT: Incidentally the Sergeant at Arms is out after the other senators who are out.

SENATOR MARSH: I would like to draw to this body's attention that we currently have 284, 587 dollars in money this year. And this is to be increased to \$298,537 to underwrite the Goodrich plan. We have remissioned staff benefits, salaries and wages for people who are working with these students. I would urge you to vote no on this amendment and have these amendments come before the appropriations committee when we are in our in our hearing session and not squeeze them in the last minute and try and make it sound like we have not put any money for the budget for the current year, when we have \$298,000 already for the year 74-75 in our current budget.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett. What's the matter, Senator Syas for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SYAS: We understood the committee in here is having a hearing, for your hearing testimony and you said you..there was a call of the house and we had a commit...

PRESIDENT: No, there is no call of the house.

SENATOR SYAS: Then why did you send down after us?

PRESIDENT: To get a quorum.

SENATOR SYAS: All right, you have got it haven't you.

PRESIDENT: That is the Chair's understanding, yes.

SENATOR SYAS: Now, you will have to have the committee excused to finish the hearing.

PRESIDENT: All right. It's your announcement then, to take your committee back out, Senator Syas. Senator Syas is taking his committee reassemble.
