PRESIDENT: Well, I'm sorry that wasn't the instructions from the Chair. All right once again we will attempt the continuation of the discussion on the Goodrich amendment to 1054. And Senator Barnett has the floor. Se nator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I'm wondering how many people we do have in here, if we have enough to continue on, or if we should lay out and recess for about another thirty minutes and give them a chance to get done with their committee. I do want to talk on the issue, but I just bring that up a question..do we have a quorum now. We do have a quorum. O.K. I'd like to ask Senator Goodrich...I have talked on this once and I'm sure that I get two times so I would like to visit with Senator Goodrich and ask him a question or to.

PRESIDENT: Very good Senator Barnett, you may visit with Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR BARNETT: I hate to have you man that gavel. It just sort of bugs me.

PRESIDENT: The front line troops don't like to have me bang this gavel either.

SENATOR BARNETT: I can understand.

PRESIDENT: The confusion in the chamber and its difficult to hold that down to a minimum.

SENATOR BARNETT: Where is Senator Goodrich. Oh, here he is he scared me to death.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to ask the questions at close or do you want him to go back to his microphone.

SENATOR BARNETT: O.K. I'm going to ask Senator Goodrich a question. He's here and...

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute. Do we assume Senator Goodrich ..

SENATOR GOODRICH: I yield.

PRESIDENT: All right, let's make sure of what we are discussing at the present time. The Chair understands that we are discussing and I hope the body understands it also, we're looking at the second part of amendment #4, that is found on page 1318 of the Legislative journal, and the Chair understands we are looking at what pertains to an amount of \$15,000 and \$25,000 of the second part of the amendment. That's what under discussion at this particular time. Now Senator Barnett had the floor, but now apparently Senator Goodrich wants the floor. Now Senator Barnett do you want to yield the floor to Senator Goodrich.

SEANTOR GOODRICH: The thought that I had in mind was to divide the question that again on the second portion of the Goodrich amendment we divide that question to separate the \$25,000 for a legal training at UNO and the Goodrich plan \$15,000. We have had an amendment drafted to accomplish that end if that is the wish of the body. But in the meantime we are just discussing the united second portion of my amendment.
