That will come up next. Now this one, is strictly the \$5,000 amendment for miscellaneous operating expenses on the Goodrich Plan at UNO, and that's all I'm asking for at this time. This is the one that Senator Chambers, Senator Mahoney, and a group of other stood up this morning and said yes, we need. And it's for that reason that I am going to stick with it and ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer. He was closing on his first half of that half and I asked you, and I tried to recognize you. Thank you, Sir. Now we are voting on the first half of the Goodrich amendment involving the \$15,000 tht the portion we are voting on. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The second portion of the amendment has been divided and you are now voting ...I realize that... This is a separate amendment for \$15,000 to continue the Goodrich plan. Senator Goodrich.
