PRESIDENT: Steady.. Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: All I would like to correct is that we could put it in the Budget Committee, in the Budget Bill saying that we could go \$80,000 or whatever it is, and could not be spent unless it was matched by the public power, and it is perfectly legal to do it, and I don't see why in the world they shouldn't then pay their part of it. It's just as right as any thing else it could only be spent if they come up with their share of the money.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Goodrich do you care to respond.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, Senator Clark, stay on your feet I have a question. Now, when we put it in that way, we're saying, you are reversing it a little bit. You are saying we put in \$80,000 or whatever we put in, and we say it can't be spent unless they appropriate their portion of it. We are not directing them to do it. What if they don't do it? Then we can't spend the money right?

SENATOR CLARK: Then they can't spend the money. That is very true.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, then we are back in the same problem that we started with right now.

SENATOR CLARK: If they are obligated for it, they should come up with their money, we are coming up with ours.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis, did you want to be heard on the issue. Wait a minute, Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I had a question, Senator Goodrich. Is Offut Airbase have a deal like this?

SENATOR GOODRICH: No, they do not. No, that's why we had to do something somewhere, do we picked the Med School to do it.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I ask for the question.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called, does the chair see 5 hands. Thank you, the question is, shall the debate now close on the amendment. All those in favor of closing debate vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to close debate on the issue. This is a Goodrich involving \$160,000 The motion is to close debate.
