SENATOR CARPENTER: In order to simplify it, Mr. President, I move that my amendments be rejected. And I ask for a vote.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Carpenter, do I understand you're withdrawing your motion? Are you withdrawing your motions?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Or what?

PRESIDENT: To this bill right now? To LB656, it's on General File. You had these motions on file. Are you going to have them withdrawn. I have to have some motion to lay them over as you suggested. But it was my understanding that you did not want to bypass these motions if the bill didn't move on over to Select File.

SENATOR CARPENTER: What I want to do if I can is move the bill from General File to E & R for Initial. Whatever amendments I have be held on Select File or I move to dispose of them and reject them. Whatever I can do, I'll leave it up to the Chair.

PRESIDENT: All right, well, we'll just hold the amendments and we'll just not take them up at this time, fine and dandy. Now, do we have other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: The Carpenter amendment will then be shown as withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is a Cavanaugh amendment. This is printed on page 1294 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: That's my problem. There are other amendments. Now, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move my amendments be withdrawn. I'll hold them until Select File.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The Cavanaugh's amendment is withdrawn. Now, what other amendments do we have to the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion.

PRESIDENT: All right, read the motion.

CLERK: I move to indefinitely postpone LB656. Signed, Senator Stahmer.
