

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would accept the opportunity that Senator Nore has so kindly extended and I wouldn't want to follow his employees around, I would want to do the same work he does, and I want to bestow upon him the title the most benevolent man in Nebraska, you are very generous.

PRESIDENT: The motion is shall LB665 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor of advancement of the bill will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Once again, the Chair would inquire, have you all voted? Alright Senator F. CARSTENS, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR F. CARSTENS: Where is everybody?

PRESIDENT: Does that answer your question. A Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays and 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: After one hour and forty-five minutes LB665 is advanced, the first bill off of general file. Now then, this brings up LB754.

CLERK: Read LB754.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron are you handling the amendments?

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the amendments be adopted. The amendments adds or gives the board the authority to employ an attorney at a minimum salary of \$600 per month and including a staff for an attorney. That is basically all the amendment does. It gies them the authority to employ an attorney. Senator Carpenter's amendment and I move for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: We are discussing the committee amendments. Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members of the body, I'm not opposed to having an attorney for this board. I would point out however that we did add the two assistant attorney generals to work with the various boards. I wonder if we can't take the money for those two assistants and ear mark as we did before on one of these same people for the Indian Affairs Commision or whatever it was for a why we can't take this instead of adding yet another person. I think that was the reason the budget committee added two or three of these people to work with these various boards.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer. Chair didn't hear a motion did they or an amendment?

SENATOR STAHMER: I wonder if Senator Waldron would object if I offered this amendment on Select File to take the money out of what we already have so as to not slow this bill up tonight. We have already appropriated money for two extras that are not yet assigned and I would just like to sign one of those to this board. I don't think that we need that many additional people.
