PRESIDENT: All the amendment...are there objections to withdraw the amendment. Hearing none. So ordered. All right, Senator Moylan we are back now to...Excuse me, just a minute.. are there any other amendments to the bill. All right, we are back to the original bill. Now, Senator Moylan do you want to be heard on the original bill.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, I could have answered some of the questions that Senator Chambers is asking. Several years back there have been abuses in the SID as far as building and over building what they were able to finance. However in 1969 we passed legislation which gave the city the power and the county to control these buildings and keep them within limits of the power of lthe SID to pay. Senator Morgan worked on that and we had the legislation, and I also ask Senator Dickinson at the time of the hearing on this bill if this bill would repeal those sections that had been put in there and they assured me that they did not repeal those sections. But..so that is taking care of any more and protected.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich. Your light is on, I presume you want to discuss the bill.

SENATOR GOODRICH: No, I was just going to respond to Senator try to answer some of Ser~~tor~~ Chambers questions, but they are mute now, so I will pass.

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any further discussion of the bill. All right then, Senator Dicksinson we are back to you for the original motion on 757.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. President, have we adopted...Senator Kremer the committee chairman has not given any input. Have we adopted the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: They were adopted a while back, Yes.

CLERK: The committee amendments were adopted on February 26.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Oh, very good.

PRESIDENT: That's so long ago, that even I lost track of them.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I will briefly explain the bill then, and this will answer further some of Senator Chambers questions, I believe. The bill simply allows two or more Sanitary Improvement Districts to join together to do the things that they now do singly. And the purpose being to have swimming pools and what have you built more efficiently with less obligation so when the city and in almost in all cases, the city ultimately annexes these areas. That they will not then be forced to take over an obligation and operate and inefficient swimming pool and an inefficient play ground park or whatever it may be. And by so doing this, and with the revamping the method of the election of the boards, it should improve the status of SID's and the complaints of their residents. I move for the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall LB757 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Once again have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of 757. All right. Clerk will record.
