SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I think I can explain this.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I think I can explain what happened in the first place, this bill was referred back to committee last year, the committee then adopted amendments in committee which became the bill. That's the white...that is the complete white copy That where we are now.

PRESIDENT: All right, now have we read the title of the bill. All right, now wait a minute. All right, we now have LB127 before us, there are series of amendments. We are going to take them in the line that they were offered. Excuse me, in the way they were put up on the Clerk's desk. That's the only way the Chair knows how to do this. Want you to also know that pending someplace down the list here is a motion to indefinitely postpone. Now, we will take the first amendment. I understand those are the white ...those were the white committee amendments, but they are not the committee amendments at this time, but they will have to be offered as that because they can't be offered as committee amendments at this time. Senator Barnett. Back to you.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman, I would move that we adopt the committee amendments, which is the Req. 2529 which sets right in front of your bill book. And then at this time I would move for the adoption of the amendments and turn it over to Senator DeCamp who will work with me in helping this. This is Senator DeCamp's idea, and we will try to answer the questions as they come up on the floor.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator DeCamp, back to you.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature. This is probably the first time and the last time I will ever explain a bill in this particular way I am going to now. I am going to explain the bill, I am going to give the arguments both and for it and against it. As I told you I made the motion to kill the bill in committee. I have sponsored the bill for two or three years now. I have more time and blood in this bill.....
