

SENATOR DE CAMP: This will apply to individuals borrowing more than \$50,000. If a cattle feeder wants to borrow more and wants to have the same rights of a corporation he would have it under this bill.

SENATOR NORE: How many cattle can you borrow or buy for \$50,000?

SENATOR DE CAMP: How many cattle can you....it would depend upon weight they were Senator.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? If not, are you ready for the question? The question is shall...approval of the bill adopt the bill. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote.-.Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: A record vote.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter is requesting a record vote. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The question precisely is for the advancement of the bill. Senator DeCamp is asking that the bill be advanced. Have you all voted? We are now going to call for the recording of the vote. Clerk will record.
