CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: House under call next bell please indicate your presence. House is under call. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Move the call be raised.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich moved the call be raised. All in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 23 AYES, 7 NAYS.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised. Now Senator Syas, or wait, that is not yet. Clerk will announce the count on the...

CLERK: 28 ayes, 4 nays to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.
