SENATOR MARVEL: No, I'm just looking through the notes.

SPEAKER: Senator we are on LB302.

CLERK: Explained amendments.

SENATOR MARVEL: Those are the amendments Mr. President, I think that this is an appropriations bill, legislation that was referred to the committee on Public Health and Welfare and I think that the amendments that you referred too. The amendment that you referred to should be taken up by Senator Kelly as a...a...by Senator Kennedy as chairman of the public health and welfare committee and if he starts discussing, I'll come up and take a look at the other sets of amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President, I move to adopt the amendments as the Clerk has read them. These amendments are to strike the original sections 1-16 and they are in the book in a white copy. I would move that we adopt those amendments. This was similar amendments that we had in last year that do state what counties and what district and they are minor amendments but they are the same amendments that we were discussing a year ago.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion?

CLERK: Read

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy is it to adopt the computer print-out amendments?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes the white.....

CLERK: Read additional amendments.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would move to have these two included so that our federal funds would coincide.

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy are you through explaining the amendments?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes.

SPEAKER: Senator Syas, are you ready for the question on the adoption of the amendments as explained by Senator Kennedy. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, it is request 2592 is what we are adopting and I...isn't that correct?

CLERK: Explained what amendments.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Then adopt 2592 after we adopt the two committee amendments. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the amendments vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record. This requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? I'm going to record the vote unless there is a motion. Senator Kennedy.
