

CLERK: Read Marvel amendment

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I ask unanimous consent to have it laid over and we have time we will consider it on Select File.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, I'll make an attempt to do it.
