

SENATOR CARSTEN: Alright.

SENATOR KENNEDY: This would take care of a number of problems over the state where these people are. Their community where they shop and so forth where they are now providing those services may continue. I would move for the adoption of this particular amendment at this time.

SENATOR CARSTEN: A.....

PRESIDENT: Do you all understand the amendment? Question is do you want to adopt the Kennedy amendment? This is the Kennedy amendment. All those vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting on the Kennedy Amendment. Have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: (mike not activated)

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted. Are there other amendments?

CLERK: Read amendments

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: These are my amendments but I'm going to yield to Senator Stahmer, he wanted to carry them.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President due to the lateness of the hour and the few people that are here I would move now to advance this bill to E & R Initial we can...when we have more people here and we have better attention, the machines are not even working we can take these amendments up on Select File. I move to advance the bill now to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Well stand by. What are we going to do with the Goodrich amendment. We have to withdraw it or....

SENATOR STAHMER: I don't want to consider it now and he yielded to me and I think that it is not appropriate to even try to consider it now. I think that...

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, do you concur? Is that alright? What is your pleasure? The issue before the body is your amendment.

SENATOR GOODRICH: For the sake of moving the bill I would withdraw my amendments and if we are going to do anything at all with them we would put them on on Select File.

PRESIDENT: Thank you sir. Any further discussion of the bill? Now the question is do you want to advance...Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Are we about to advance the bill?

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I haven't even started arguing about the bill.

PRESIDENT: Proceed, you have the floor. Senator Goodrich has withdrawn, at least for the moment, his last amendment, apparently the last amendment to the bill.
