CLERK: We adopted the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: We are now to 933 and there are amendments. Motion is to advance 933 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, those opposed say no. 933 is advanced.

CLERK: 665.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: (inaudible)

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to 665. All those in favor of adoption of the amendments say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill? Now the motion is to advance 665 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, those opposed say no. Bill is advanced.
