SENATOR SYAS: We either have to make a motion, or have to have a question answered before I vote on this bill.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, which do you want me to do.

PRESIDENT: Well, you can ask a question.

SENATOR SYAS: All right, what does. Maybe I've got the wrong copy. Is that declaring that you are a candidate at a public meeting and is that in the purple copy. I noticed it is in the other copy.

PRESIDENT: Who can answer that question for Senator Syas? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, the...Senator Syas, the only reference I see here is...any person who enrolls himself or herself out as a candidate for elective office, and receives contributions on that basis shall file all financial reports as required by law, as if he or she were a candidate.

SENATOR SYAS: Do I interpret that that unless you receive contributions you are not a candidate unless you receive..

SENATOR WARNER: Unless you receive and accept, I believe. Well, it just says receives. Yes, you are not a candidate unless you are accepting contributions.

SENATOR SYAS: Unless you accept contributions you are not a candidate. All right.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will read. LB877

CLERK: LB 877 (read)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, 'Shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached?' Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, 6 not voting. (Printed on page 1419)

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency attached. Clerk will read LB 897.
