If there are questions, you can help out. We adopted 647. These amendments simply shift the money from the District Court to the Supreme Court. Now would you care to add some explanation to it? This is strictly a technical shift, as I understand, but you might help out with an explanation if you would.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Senator Marvel, that is correct. That is all it does, it's a technical shift from one to the other.

CLERK: This is the amendment on 1392?

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, I move the adoption of that series of amendments that you find on bottom of page 1392 through 1393.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on these? Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of adopting the amendments as explained by Senator Marvel, say aye. Opposed no. Now, we have to vote on these, all in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Amendments are adopted. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: No response.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there are...there are a series of individual amendments pending. They start on page 1319. It's offered by Senator Carpenter. Okay, it's amendment 8 which is the next one. Page 1319 of the Legislative Journal. Now, Senator Carpenter asks unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment and offer a substitute amendment.

PRESIDENT: Well, if he wants to withdraw them, they're withdrawn. Is that right, Senator Carpenter, you want to withdraw them? They're withdrawn.

CLERK: Okay, in lieu thereof, he offers the following amendment and this hasn't been printed.

SENATOR CARPENTER: No response.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: If you'll go to page 1319, you'll find that the amendments on the Clerk's desk, I have stricken. The second paragraph which.....

says "The Director and Administrator shall make no acquisitions or replacements," etc. Now that is the matter that is stricken out of the first amendment and the second amendment is what's printed in the Journal without that particular section.
